### <u>Math</u>

This week we will finish Topic B in Module 1. The students will practice fluency when subtracting from ten when the subtrahend is greater than the ones digit. They will also be participating in activities and games dealing with place value.

Our math coaches are really stressing that we do not teach the algorithm to the kids before they understand the concept in math. For instance, does your child really understand place value when a problem is presented in this way?

It is important that they understand that they are not borrowing one from the 5 and changing it to 4 but they are borrowing 1 ten and changing it to 4 tens.

Research shows that spending an adequate time on place value is necessary in the beginning to ensure understanding.
