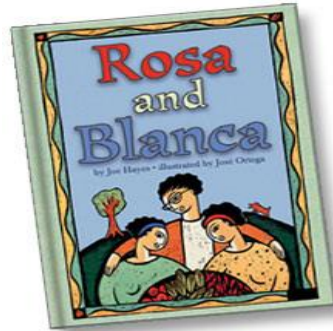


Box Tops

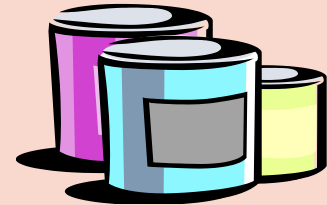
