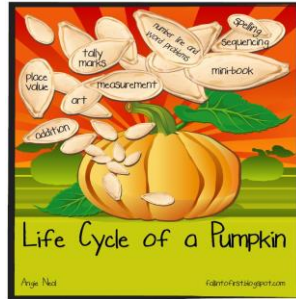


The date of the field trip is February 28th. It is my understanding that there is no limit on chaperones. Details and permission slips will go home in early February.

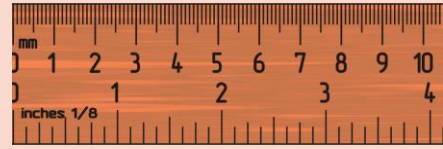

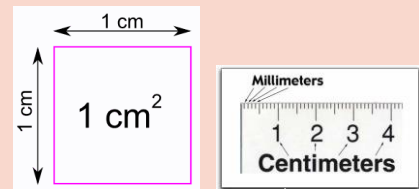


We will continue with Module 2:
