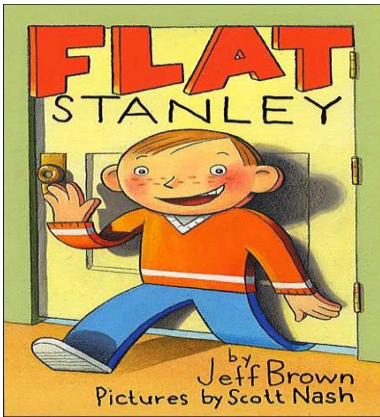
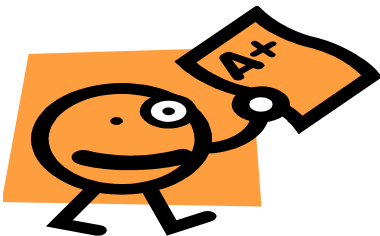


Brown's Paw Prints

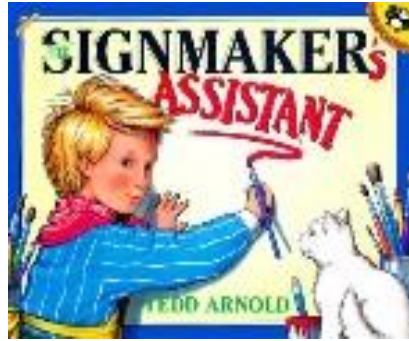
